The club has extended an invitation to attend this program to all members of the Greater Washington Council of Camera Clubs and the All-Maryland Council of Camera Clubs. To accommodate the large crowd anticipated, this meeting will be held in the Community Meeting Room on the lower level of the Sears Whiteoak store. Time - 8:00 p.m. Arrive early for a good seat.

Mr. Rothschild's illustrated lecture will be in two parts, with an intermission, and a question-answer period following the show. No slide competition will be held.

Sears Whiteoak is located at the intersection of Route 29 and New Hampshire Avenue extended, two miles north of the Beltway. The K-6 bus line (New Hampshire Avenue) from downtown Washington runs right to the door. Plenty of parking is available.

NORMAN ROTHSCHILD

Norman Rothschild is technical editor of Popular Photography magazine for which he writes articles on a wide variety of subjects, including equipment, films, and photographic aids. His specialty is the use of color materials in creative ways.

An enthusiast of photography for forty years, he began processing and printing at the age of twelve. At fourteen he was a studio assistant, and by the time he was sixteen Rothschild was a professional darkroom man and freelance photographer. During World War II he served as a U.S. Signal Corps photographer.

Since 1952 he has been writing about photography as well as taking pictures. In addition to his many activities as a professional photographer, lecturer and technical consultant, Rothschild is the author of three books. He currently teaches photography at the School of Visual Arts in New York City, where he lives.

A Past President of the Village Camera Club in New York, and former Vice-President of the New York Color Slide Club, he has had a great number of his pictures published.
