An enthusiast of photography for forty years, he began processing and printing at the age of twelve. At fourteen he was a studio assistant, and by the time he was sixteen Rothschild was a professional darkroom man and freelance photographer. During World War II he served as a U.S. Signal Corps photographer.

Since 1952 he has been writing about photography as well as taking pictures. In addition to his many activities as a professional photographer lecturer and technical consultant, Rothschild is the author of three books. He currently teaches photography at the School of Visual Arts in New York City, where he lives.

A Past President of the Village Camera Club in New York, and former Vice-President of the New York Color Slide Club, he has had a great number of his pictures published.
