APRIL MEETINGS

At the April 3rd color meeting, Ed Bafford of the Baltimore Camera Club will present his show "Color Composition."

In the workshop session Leon Rothenberg will show how to make slides from black and white prints.

Our guest speaker for the black and white meeting on April 17th will be announced at the April 3rd meeting.

During the black and white workshop session Berle Cherney will demonstrate the use of a Kodak stabilizer in making prints.

EXHIBITION "THE ART OF PHOTOGRAPHY"

The Maryland Council of Camera Clubs will present an exhibition "The Art of Photography" between May 25 and June 15 in the Art Lounge of the Jewish Community Center, 5700 Park Heights Avenue, Baltimore with the cooperation of the J.C.C. Camera Club.

Prints will be exhibited which show the wide range of technique and individual approach in good amateur photography. Entries will be selected to demonstrate imaginative and varied interpretations of the several subject categories. Individuals are encouraged to submit several pictures in a single category, and clubs or smaller groups to select one or more categories and work on them intensively.

APRIL COMPETITION CATEGORY

STILL LIFE, TABLE TOPS

About 225 prints will be hung, 15 in each category, and merit awards will be given for prints of outstanding excellence.

The categories are: Photo Stories (groups of pictures mounted together which show a sequence of events); The Four Seasons - Essay (four prints mounted together); Close-ups; The Animal Kingdom; People at Work; Patterns and Abstractions; Character Portraits; Humor; Stopped Motion; Rain; Religion; Maryland Landscapes; Parent and Child; The Baltimore Scene.

Regulations: 1) entrants must be members of a club affiliated with the Maryland Council of Camera Clubs; 2) there is no limit on the number of entries; 3) prints must be mounted and show the category in which the print is to be considered; 4) mounts may not exceed 16x20 but may range downward to 5x7 or smaller; 5) the Photo Stories and Four Seasons Essay categories are strictly for groups of pictures, but in the other categories several pictures may be mounted together; 6) prints may be entered for sale if desired with price marked on the back (10% commission to the JCC Art Fund); 7) closing date is May 5 and selections will be made May 18. All unsold work will be returned to the maker's club by June 30.

In connection with the opening of the exhibit on May 25 there will be a showing in the JCC auditorium of the accepted color slides from the 1969 Baltimore International Salon.
