The school will be held at the 4-H

who will give a slide-illustrated talk
on "Pictorial Photography in Black and
White and Color," and Dorothy Wohltman
of New York, who will discuss the retouching of slides. The title of her
program will be, "The Magic Touch." In
addition, on Saturday Mrs. Wohltman will
present a slide program entitled, "People
Make the Difference."

On Saturday morning and afternoon black and white and color workshops will be given by local photographers on a variety of subjects. In the area of black and white photography they will treat exposure, print quality, and special techniques. In the field of color photography they will discuss film comparison and the use of black light.
