PHOTOGRAPHER OF THE YEAR AWARDS

A new feature has been added to encourage competition. Four "Photographer of the Year" awards will be given at the end of each club year. One will go to each of the club members accumulating during the year the highest score in a class. The classes are Novice and Advanced Color Slide and Novice and Advanced Black and White Prints. Scoring will be 1st place - 6 points, 2nd place - 4 points, 3rd place 2 points and honorable mention - 1 point. (This is the same as used in overall cumulative scores limiting eligibility for competition in Novice Classes.)

The Highest cumulative annual score will be the sole basis for selecting the member who has done the most outstanding photography in each class during the club year.
