WHO LIKES YOUR PICTURES?

The following is quoted from Photo-Vision, by Ray Bethers, St. Martins Press, Inc., New York, N.Y.:

"If you want to sell your photographs, published photographs would seem to suggest that you take only pin-up girls or cute little kittens. If you wish to win camera club awards, just study past prize-winners and take these same pictures all over again, and if it is your wife you are trying to please with your pictures, just analyse her taste and incline all your talents in that direction.

In other words, all pictures are not for all purposes or all people, and no one picture can possibly please everyone. So may I suggest that the only true satisfaction in picture making is to be found in first pleasing yourself.

You must do this without regard to what anyone says, for each person will say something different, depending on his or her differing points of view, experience, passing mood and background. However, this does not mean to entirely disregard criticism, but to accept only the suggestions that can be assimilated as part of you.

To sustain a personal viewpoint requires courage and integrity, but you will never take a lasting and creative picture without creating it entirely in your own way. Otherwise you will only imitate or copy other people's personal points of view."
