MORE ON EMULSIONS . . .

From Bill Meenahan, some more special emulsion items to add to last month's list:

ALL-MD

The date of the All-Maryland Club Contest has been set for March 12, 1972. Since the no. of entries each club can submit in each category is limited, all entries must be submitted no later than the B&W meeting in Feb., FEBRUARY 17, to permit the club's selection committee to pick the entries which will represent the club in the contest.

Also, the All-Md is still seeking members who can give a program or act as a judge at some of the other clubs in the Council. If you are willing to do this, please contact Bernie Blass.

Edmund Scientific has a Photopolymerization Kit (No. 71,055, \$10 Ppd) which makes photo reproductions on glass, metal or cheesecloth. The kit makes 20 oz. of photosensitive liquid which may be coated on any surface. When exposed to light, the liquid turns into plastic, creating a 3-dimensional photo or lithograph plate. In the unexposed areas, the solution remains a liquid and is poured off and saved. You can incorporate other materials into the plastic pictures: fine sand, powdered glass, pigments or fluorescent chalk ground to a fine powder. Eastman Kodak has announced a technique for creating etched photos on glass surfaces with a photosensitive resist. Ink, pigment or epoxy paint is then rubbed into the etched surface. Additional effects can be produced by edge lighting the etched image, or by backlighting an image etched in the silvered back of a mirror. Depth relationships can be produced by etching the main subject on the front surface of a glass or mirror and etching a background scene on the rear surface.
