Categories are Monochrome Prints, Color Prints, and Color Slides. Cost is \$1.00 per category. Limit is 4 entries per category. Classes are Unlimited (SSCC-Advanced), Advanced (applicable to B&W prints only-open to SSCC advanced), Novice (SSCC Novice). You may not enter in a class lower than what you compete in in SSCC. Once you enter in a class you may not enter in a lower class. If you win a "first" in a class, you must move up to the next higher class.

Prints must have All-Md label on back; sizes---Unlimited-maximum is 16x20; B&W Advanced-maximum is 11x14; B&W Novice-maximum is 8x10; Color Novice-maximum is 11x14. Any print may be mounted on a board up to 16x20. Slides must be thumb spotted on lower left as correctly viewed and must be marked with name, title, club and class.

Any entries which has been entered in previous All-Md contest and won a 1st, 2nd or 3rd place or has been entered in more than one prior All-Md contest may not be re-entered. Print entrants should be aware that if they win a ribbon (place or HM), their prints will be held for exhibition. All other entries will be returned at SSCC's November 21st meeting.
