PICTURE YOUR PARKS CONTEST WINNERS ANNOUNCED

The top award in The Maryland National Capital Park and Planning Commission's summer-long Picture Your Parks photography contest went to Miss Marianne Keffer of Rockville. Miss Keffer's single entry, a color photo of a sunrise seen through a stand of trees, was selected from the more than 110 entries by the panel of judges as the Grand Award Winner. As a result, Marianne won a handsome plaque and an eight-foot-tall Chinese dogwood tree.

Miss Keffer's prize-winning picture, along with all of the other winners have been assembled into a traveling exhibit. In future weeks, the exhibit will be on display in libraries and shopping centers throughout Montgomery and Prince George's Counties.

The Picture Your Parks contest will be repeated next year. Photographers from both Montgomery and Prince George's Counties are eligible and those photographs entered in next year's contest must have been taken between September 7, 1973 and September 13, 1974; the closing date for Picture Your Parks '74.

The contest's coordinator, John Bittner, noted that while he was pleased with both the quality and quantity of the photographs entered, he was "a little bit disappointed with the relatively small number of youngsters who entered prints in the junior categories." He was also surprised at the fact that there was only one entry that pictured sports action.
