Silom Horwitz has been making pictures since 1929 and began making color prints in 1958. He has been quite active in the Photographic Society of America and is a Star Exhibitor in both color and monochrome prints. He was awarded his Associateship in 1973. Mr. Horwitz is the Editor of the Techniques Division Supplement and Assistant Editor of the PS&T Section of the PSA Journal. His article on the Cibachrome process appeared in the April 1975 PSA Journal. He is a founder and first President of the Northern Virginia Camera Club and currently teaches in the Fairfax County Adult Education Program. He will discuss with us the making of prints from slides using the Cibachrome and Ektachrome (1993) processes. He will judge the print competition for the evening.
