As usual, SSCC will retain 10% of the sales price up to a maximum of \$10. At their option, members may specify that a larger percentage or all of the proceeds from their item or service be donated to the Club, by so indicating on their sales card or tag.

Only SSCC members may offer items or services for auction; however, everyone present may participate in the bidding -- including members, visitors, and the auctioneers!
