## AUCTION

SSCC's annual photo auction will be held at the Jan. 19 (WEDNESDAY) print meeting. Although nonmembers are welcome --only SSCC members may offer items for sale. The Club collects 10% of each sale, with a MINIMUM of \$.50, and a MAXIMUM of \$10.00. That is, if an item sells for \$.40, YOU owe the Club a dime, if an item sells for \$250.00, the Club only takes \$10. If you have a number of small items, you may package them to sell as a group, or you may put them on a special table where items are sold on a first come basis, with all going to the Club. You may indicate that more than 10%, (or all,) proceeds go to the Club on any item. We are a tax exempt, nonprofit organization, and you MAY be able to declare a tax deduction for such a contribution. All items must be clearly marked with your name, any applicable description, and a minimum bid price (if any). Finally, the auction is not limited to photo equipment, you may offer photo services or prints, etc. for sale.

WILLIAM A. DUGGAN will present a slide program entitled "Techniques of Stereo-Photography". Bill will demonstrate four techniques currently in use for the production of stereo transparencies. His demonstration materials are drawn from a diverse range of subject matter; flowers, human figures, and scenes from Europe and the Orient. His interest in photography began with a \$1 Baby Brownie and developed over the years by self instruction. Most of his graduate school expenses were earned by presenting slide shows of his travels in Europe while on duty with the Army.

He was affiliated with the Jackson Park Camera Club of Chicago and is currently active in the Stereo Division of the Photographic Society of America. Bill is currently Chairman of the Department of Economics and Business Administration at Luther Rice College in Alexandria.

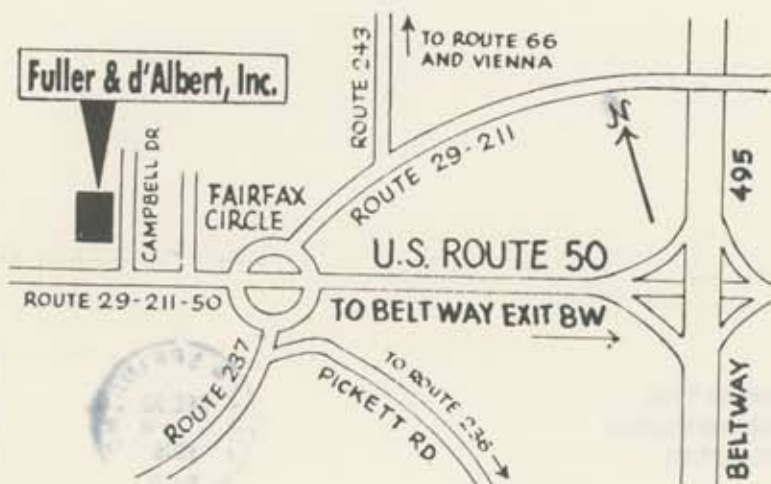

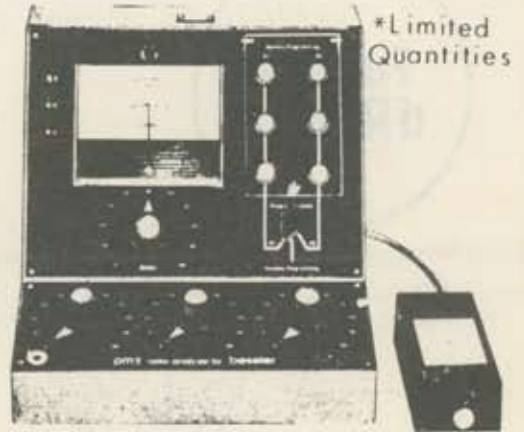

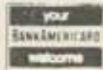
