Directions to November Digital Workshop


- 1. From Beltway 495, take the Georgia Ave. (North) Exit. Continue North on Georgia Ave. until you pass Randolph Road.
- 2. Stay in the right lane and turn right onto Layhill Road.
- 3. Proceed north on Layhill Road. At the 3rd traffic light, turn right onto Sullivan Lane.
- 4. Go about 3-4 blocks and make a left onto Wagon Way.
- 5. Go 1/4 mile to 14020 Wagon Way (on your left).




Our guest speaker for the December Slide meeting will be SSCC's own Don Becker.




