Photography as Sculpture category is defined as a mixed media, three-dimensional (non-"flat") artwork composed of one or more of the artist's photographic images — using a dynamic combination of materials, methods, concepts, and subjects that challenge traditional boundaries and defy easy definition — work that presents photography in a non-traditional, unique way.

This category does NOT include: texture on the surface of a two-dimensional (flat) print; stereoscopic photographs; two dimensional (flat) prints that portray a perspective-shifting, pseudo-3D image.
