The Basics of Intentional Camera Movement (ICM) By Lisa Auerbach and Wendy Kates

Definition

- ICM photography is adding the illusion of movement to a still image.
- Long exposure is crucial for this technique to achieve motion blur.
- When doing long exposures, the usual goal is to keep the camera still to produce a sharp image.
- ICM uses controlled and deliberate shake or movement using a long shutter speed.

Equipment

- Almost any camera will do.
 - You must be able to control both your shutter speed and aperture independently.
 - Phones can use a slow shutter app
 - Slow Shutter iPhone
 - Camera FV-5 android
 - ND filters 3 stop or 6 stop on a sunny day


Shutter Speed

- Manual or Shutter Priority
- · Choose your shutter speed, then
 adjust the Aperture/ISO to make that
 speed work.
- Shutter speeds tend to last from 1/15 to 2 seconds.


- Slower speeds give detailwhile faster speeds yieldmore abstract looks
- 1/15 second is a minimum suggestedspeed

Technical Issues


- Neutral density filters are important if you go out in daylight because your shutter speed will be longer, letting in more light in the image.
- If you don't use an ND, then use a high aperture so your image is not blown out.
 An ND 6 stop has been most mentioned in my reading.

- Image Stabilization Off- You want a blur. You do not want a sharp image.
- Faster movements give more blur.

 Slower give a smoother blur.
- Look for color, lines, textures,
 patterns, light, just as you do in still photography.



Brookside Gardens 1/8 sec f/4

- A tripod is helpful for either a zoom in or out -OR-camera turn in a half circle. If you want a straight up/down or left/right look, then a tripod can help although it is not necessary. For a free flowing movement, don't use a tripod.
- Manual focus lets the camera flow, not lock onto a subject. When zooming, do lock the focus on the center for a clear center and blurred zoom.

Shutter Press

- 2 second delay. Press shutter button, count 2 seconds, then begin moving.
- Single shot and begin moving right away.
- Start the sweep, then press the shutter once you get to spot you want to capture.
- Find your own preference.










Rotation

• Rotate the whole camera a turn in either direction. ¹/₄ rotation works. You don't have to have full circle. Not the lens but the whole camera



Zoom Burst

• Zoom in or out on a subject. I find a tripod useful. If you keep your focus point on the center object, it will stay clear.


Diagonal

• Corner to opposite corner going diagonally in either directions







- Hold camera in front and use a shaky movement of your hands,

 Combining more than one ICM image can be very effective.

 Many cameras combine the images in-camera.

 But images can also be combined with post-processing software







- Apps
 - Slow Shutter Cam for iPhones
 - Camera FV-5 for Androids



Challenges

- Subject needs a lot of color contrast
- Usually requires post-processing
 - Contrast
 - Texture
 - Vibrance
- Multiple exposure ICM with Slow Shutter Cam: VERY challenging






